As we look ahead to the October concerts, we want to share some new information that is important to *all* our ticket holders. Beginning October 1<sup>st</sup>, the Jefferson Center has mandated a new COVID policy for all events, including RSO concerts.

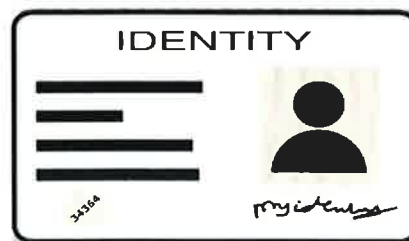
The Jefferson Center is requiring that all ticket holders (including children) show proof of vaccination **OR** present a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours of the concert. Without exception, *any ticket holder* that does not have proof of vaccination or negative test *will not* be allowed to enter the Jefferson Center.

Given how many of our RSO subscribers and patrons are vaccinated, we requested an exception but were denied. We now must abide by their policy for our concerts at the Jefferson Center.

As you enter the hall, Jefferson Center security staff will be on hand to check your vaccination status or negative test. You will also need to show a valid picture id that matches the name on the card or test. Please come a little early, we will make sure that we don't start the concert if we still have people working to show cards and enter the hall.

In addition to these entry requirements, *all patrons* must wear a mask at all times indoors. Please bring your most comfortable mask. We will have masks on hand for you if needed.
